The request for assistance from the public remained at the same level as previous years. Most of the complaints were either from noisy neighbours, leisure establishments and construction work. The Association conducted several noise surveys at the request of people suffering from noise pollution.

The survey is carried out to ascertain if the noise at the Sensitive receptor residence is of sufficient intensity to justify a complaint.

Media invites remained on par with previous years.

Main topics discussed: Noise nuisance Regulations, and guidelines regarding nuisance from noisy neighbours. The Association had a number of articles posted in the local media.

The Association is following-up the complaint presented to the EU Commission; infringement of the 'EU Law' by the Government, by a petition to the EU Parliament.
